


## Accessing Magazines in Libby

If you've never used Libby before, first follow the instructions found [at this link](#) to log into Libby for the first time.

To begin, open Libby. If you'd like to search for a specific magazine, click on the magnifying glass icon at the bottom of the Libby homepage.



Type the name of a magazine into the search bar and hit enter or click on one of the search suggestions.
